

In 3rd World Countries ...

- More than twice the population of the United States lives without access to safe water.
- Women and children spend 140 million hours a day collecting water.
- The average person walks 4 to 5 miles each day for clean water.
- The typical container for water collection in Africa weighs over 40 lbs when full.
- As much as 80% of illnesses are linked to poor water and sanitation conditions.
- TODAY, 1600 children will die because they don't have access to safe water.
- By investing in clean water alone, young children around the world can gain more than 413 million days of health.
